

Proposed RRNN Bylaw Changes

ARTICLE III – Membership and Dues, Section 1

~~B. Members agree they will not use the membership roster of the RRNN for solicitation purposes or for personal gain.~~
No distribution or reproduction of any kind, printed or uploaded on line, of the membership directory is authorized. The Directory cannot be used for solicitation purposes or personal gain by RRNN members.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP AND DUES, Section 3

Prospective members who have never been a member of the RRNN may attend each function only once prior to joining. ~~Previous members who live within a 50-mile radius from the Round Rock city limits and who have not rejoined by paying RRNN dues for the current year may not attend any RRNN functions.~~ Previous members who live within a 50-mile radius from the Round Rock city limits and whose dues have not been paid during the previous 24 months may not attend any RRNN function. Previous members who live within a 50-mile radius from the Round Rock city limits and whose dues have not been paid for 2 or more years may be reclassified as prospective new members and may enjoy the benefits available to prospective new members. Previous members who live outside a 50-mile radius from the Round Rock city limits may attend functions as guests, if space is available.

ARTICLE IV – MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS/VOTING, Section 1.

- C. ~~Twenty five percent (25%)~~ **Twenty percent (20%)** of membership will constitute a quorum for membership vote **necessary to conduct business**. A simple majority of those members attending is needed for passage of any action. In case of a tie, the President will vote to break the tie. These requirements also apply to electronic voting. **With a membership of 200, the quorum is 50. We have come close to that number at a few luncheons.**

ARTICLE V – BOARD/BOARD MEETINGS

Section 4. Board Meetings, D

- D. ~~The Board must approve all RRNN expenditures not itemized in the budget that are in excess of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25).~~ **Move to General Rules, as this amount will change due to economics changes.**

ARTICLE VIII – NON-VOTING BOARD COMMITTEES

Section 3. Committees may contain one or multiple members, and ~~may select their own chair, if any.~~ **The Board will select the Chair, if one is needed.**

~~Section 5. Committees may request monies allocated to them in the budget.~~ **Move to General Rules**
